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> Who can enter YouthX Awards

Here is how you enter:

- Have a MiGoals, MiGoals Plus, MiGoals Premium, Unlocked.me, Pay-as-you-use, Savvy Plus, Savvy Bundle Account, Private Clients, or Private Wealth Account
- Qualifying account must be in good standing.
- Have a valid South African ID.
- Be between 18 and 26 years old.

All YouthX Awards entries must be submitted on the <https://www.youthxbynedbank.co.za/youthx/youthxawards> website.

Nedbank employees (permanent, temporary or contract employees) or any of its associates, agents, contractors or sponsors may not participate.

> Entry and other dates

The YouthX event takes place on **21 November 2026 at Constitution Hill**, where the winners will be announced. Take note of the following dates:

- **Entries open:** 14 August 2026
- **Entries close:** 9 October 2026

> How to enter

Read the YouthX Awards 'How to enter' guide carefully and submit your entry on <https://www.youthxbynedbank.co.za/youthx/youthxawards> platform.

Step 1:

Visit the YouthX website

<https://www.youthxbynedbank.co.za/youthx/youthxawards>

Step 2:

Read and accept the terms and conditions, acknowledgements and disclaimers about intellectual property.

Step 3:

Give your entry a title and add a paragraph on how YouthX can help unlock the power of your X.

Step 4:

If you have worked with someone else or a group of people, give them credit. Otherwise, indicate that you have worked alone.

Step 5:

Submit a summary of your idea, in 350 words or less, in a word document.

Step 6:

Unpack and demonstrate (using sketches, prototypes, or any other examples) of your idea.

Step 7:

Upload your work to see what it looks like in totality – in other words, how the judges will see your entry.

You can save a draft of your entry and come back to edit it or add supporting material as you go along. It will be submitted only once you have indicated that your entry is final. Once done, you will no longer be able to make amendments.

> Important notes

Your entry must describe how you will solve a problem or enhance any aspect in line with the following criteria:

Creativity: 40%

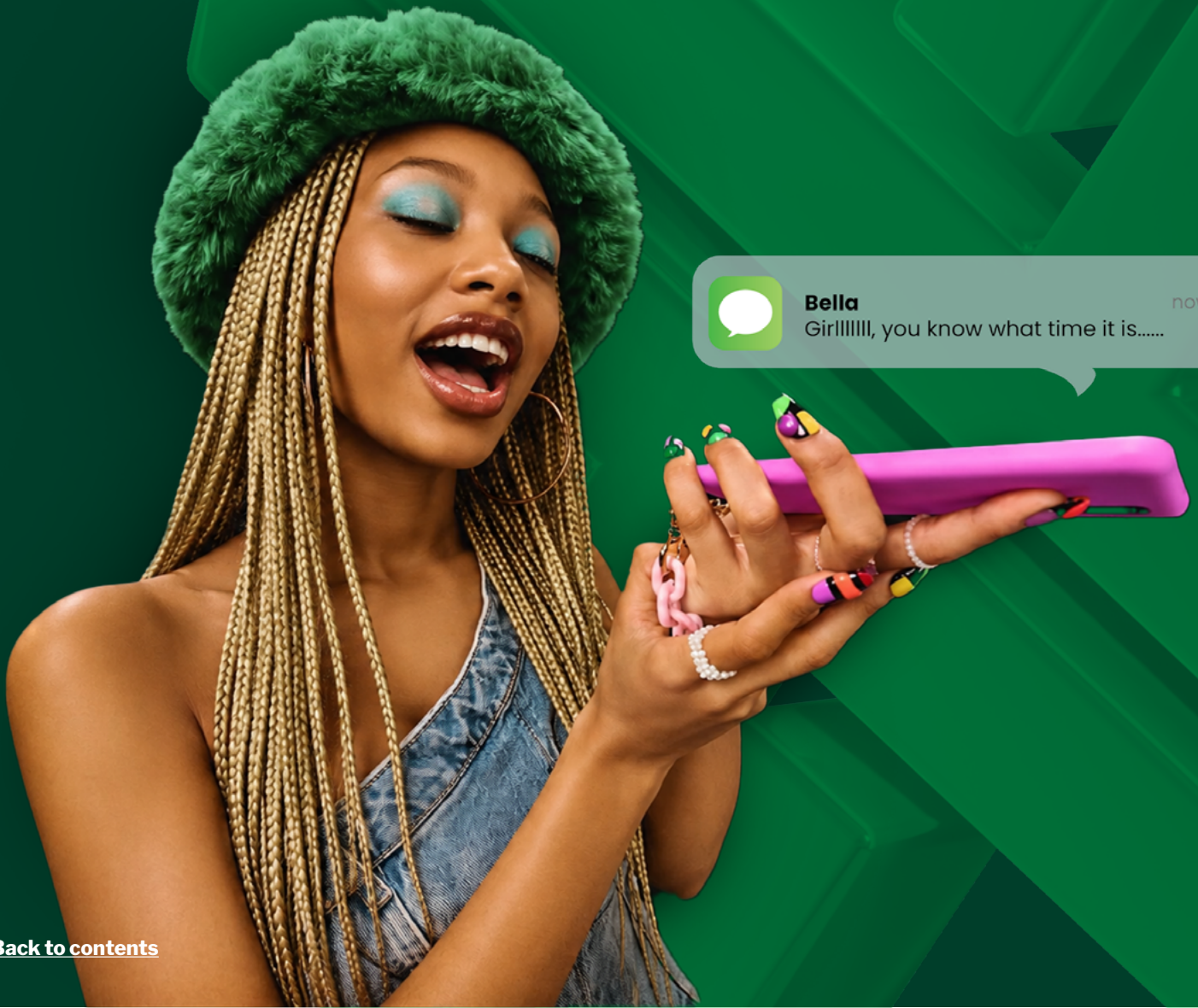
- Uniqueness of the idea (is it a new idea or something that will fill a gap in the market?). **15%**
- Quality of work submitted (its visual appeal and quality of execution). **10%**
- Implementation of the idea (is it well thought through?). **15%**

Innovation: 40%

- Strategic approach (media used or how the idea is put together – logic behind the entry). **20%**
- Market context (is it viable and realistic?). **10%**
- Objectives, target audience and implementation. **10%**

Community upliftment: 20%

- Impact (will it help people or better people's lives?). **10%**
- Reach (can it be implemented and be accessible to everyone – is it scalable?). **5%**
- Sustainability (is there room for improvement and does it have long-term viability?). **5%**



> More about the supporting material

Please read and understand this section carefully and make sure that your additional supporting material meets the following requirements before you submit your entry:

> Video

- You can add only 1 video.
- We will accept MP4 and MOV files only.
- The maximum length allowed is 90 seconds.
- The maximum size allowed is 200 MB.
- If the video is not in English, it must have English subtitles.

> Voice note

- You can add only 1 voice note.
- We will accept MP3 files only.
- The maximum length allowed is 90 seconds.
- The maximum size allowed is 5 MB.

> Images

- You can add up to 3 images.
- We will accept .jpg, .jpeg and .png files only.
- The maximum size allowed is 5 MB per image.

> PDF file

- You can add 1 PDF of 3 pages.
- The maximum size allowed is 15 MB.

> Word document

- You can add 1 Word document of 3 pages.
- We will accept .doc and .docx files only.
- The maximum size allowed is 15 MB.

Remember you should have at least **three different assets**. Eg. Video, PDF, Word doc etc to make your entry valid for judging.

> How to make your entry stand out

To make sure that your entry stands out, consider the following:

- Read and double-check all written material for any grammatical or spelling errors before you submit your entry.
- Include as many examples and proof points as possible in your supporting material and elaborate how everything works together in your summary.
- Make sure that your idea is complete and well thought through.
- Make sure that your idea is unique and be careful of plagiarism. The judges will pick up on it during the auditing process.
- Don't be afraid to mention previous failings or learnings. This shows that you are authentic and can overcome challenges.
- Keep your write-ups sweet and short, and make sure that the font is legible.
- Look at your entry from the judges' perspective before you submit it.
